INTERVIEW: SARAH PALIN:

Palin was interviewed on 5-2-05, at 1637 hours by Sgt. Wall (Molly McCann present, taped & transcribed).

Palin advised that she is Molly McCann's sister. She further stated that on February 17, 2005 she was called by Molly. She advised that Mike had called her and told her to get the f'ing home. Palin advised that she offered to come to Molly's house and that Molly had decided that she should keep an open cell phone line instead. Molly then told her that if there was a problem she could call for help.

Palin stated that she could hear Mike come home and begin screaming "f'ing this and that" over the open telephone. She then advised that she overheard Mike state that "if your dad helps you through this divorce he will eat an f'ing bullet". Palin stated that she was afraid for Molly's safety and that Mike had his gun on. She also advised that she was afraid that Mike would go to her father's residence and shoot him.

Palin advised that she could overhear Mike telling Molly that he could ruin her family, and that he has friends who are judges and who are in high places. Palin stated that she then decided to call Molly's neighbor to watch and make sure Molly was all right. When she called the neighbor she had her son Track, listen to the phone.

Palin advised that she then went to Molly's house where her and the neighbor watched Molly through the window from the neighbor's driveway. Palin stated that she stayed for approximately 15 minutes and then had to leave and drive to Chugach for a meeting. She stated that Mike and Molly had calmed down and that the neighbor continued to watch. Palin advised the reason she didn't call the police was because she didn't want to hurt Mike's career. She stated that it would put his career on the line and that as long as it wasn't physical, she wasn't going to call.

INFORMATION:

Following the interviews with McCann and Palin I prepared to leave the home. As I was preparing to leave, the two advised me of other incidents that they did not feel were appropriate. They advised that Mike told them he had an argument with the person at the Landfill because he had taken in an uncovered load of trash. The landfill attendant advised that they were going to give Mike a ticket, he then told them that he was a State Trooper and had their supervisor come talk to them. She further indicated that Mike did not get a citation. The two women also related that Mike has called in sick or stated that he needed to take care of the kids when he was hung over and didn't want to go to work.
